



DWJ Studio Rules

- ❖ Please do not enter while class is in session. Classes are closed to viewing.
- ❖ Remove outside shoes before walking across the dance floor. This keeps our dance space free of dirt and debris.
- ❖ Dance shoes are to be worn inside only. Each student should have a bag to keep their belongings in. When they arrive, they should change shoes and place all belongings and street shoes in a cubby.
- ❖ All students should go to the restroom before class. No food or drinks are permitted on the dance floor. Bottled water and snacks are available for purchase but must remain in designated area. If you prefer to bring a bottle of water, it must be able to be tightly closed and kept in the student's cubby.
- ❖ If you need to discuss anything with the instructor or studio owner, please call/text/message us to set up a time. There is not time to do this in between classes.
- ❖ Enrolled Students should be dropped off at the door 5-10 minutes before their class is scheduled to begin. Students will be dismissed to parents 5-10 minutes after their class ends. Parents should wait outside until students are dismissed by the teacher. This ensures that all students have their belongings & have received any class rewards before leaving.
- ❖ Students should wait quietly in the waiting area until the instructor invites them out to begin their class.
- ❖ *South Arkansas Students:* We have glassless mirrors at this location. Please do not touch or press on them as this will cause damage/dents/scratches.
Crow Mountain Students: FOR YOUR SAFETY DO NOT TOUCH OR LEAN ON THE MIRRORS. It is dangerous when pressure is applied to the mirrors; they are heavy and they could break and fall on you. The mirrors are not glued to the wall! Look with your eyes only!

Students don't forget...

- No Running inside the studios
- No Gum or Candy during class
- No Jewelry during class
- Hair should always be neatly pulled back out of the face and off of the neck. Clip or bobby pin any bangs or tendrils that fall into the eyes.
